EU CITIZENS IN HAMBLETON - THE UK HAS LEFT THE EUROPEAN UNION - APPLYING FOR SETTLED STATUS

Applying for EU settled status

If you are an EU Citizen who wants to continue to live in the UK, you should apply to the EU Settlement Scheme before 30 June 2021. We want you to feel that this is your home and that you can continue to live here without worry about your status. We're encouraging EU citizens in Hambleton to register for EU settled status to remain living and working in the UK. The application is free to use.

Apply for settled status now

If you're an EU citizen living in the UK you will need to apply to the EU Settlement Scheme before 30 June 2021. You can apply online on the government website, which also has up-to-date information and advice about the application process at <https://www.gov.uk/settled-status-eu-citizens-families/applying-for-settled-status>

For Hambleton residents, Citizens Advice Hambleton can help you complete your application. We can help you to apply and can also help with ID verification.

What ID documents do I need?

Your current valid biometric EU passport or ID card (if it is biometric) or a valid Biometric Residence Permit (BRP) for family members of an EU citizen; and

a mobile phone that can receive text messages or a device that can receive emails.

Only the ID documents listed above can be checked by us. If you do not have one of the ID documents listed then please visit the government website above.
